Service Agreement Form & Sign Language Interpreting Effective 08/20/2007 Number 101

SUMMARY OF UPDATES

A revised Service Agreement has been posted to VRIS. The revision provides an expanded list of the different certification levels from the National Association for the Deaf (NAD), National Interpreter Certification (NIC), Quality Assurance Screening Test (QAST), and the Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf (RID).

Reminder: All current Service Agreements for Sign Language Interpreters expire 8-31-07. New Service Agreements must be written with an effective date of 9-01-07 or later. Only interpreters on the NCDHH Registry of Licensed Interpreters can have a Service Agreement with the agency. A copy of the interpreter's License Card and Certification Level Card must accompany the Service Agreement. The NDE Administrative Memorandum 112 becomes effective 09-01-07 with the new fees and classification levels.
