SUMMARY OF UPDATES

- 1. The Employment Warranty Program converts to Post Employment on Thursday, August 1.
- 2. Clients currently receiving services in an open EW case will continue receiving services until they are completed.
- 3. Post Employment Services will be available for 1 year from the date of original Successful Outcome. At the end of one year cases will automatically receive the PE Period Ended milestone.
- 4. Lists of clients who have been in EW Monitoring for more than one year will automatically receive the PE Period Ended Milestone. These cases need to be filed in the Fiscal Year that the original outcome was taken. When these lists are posted on VRIS the link will be provided to the teams.
- 5. If a client is receiving PE services and it is determined a new case needs to be opened QE2 will automatically terminate the open PE case when you select the "create new I & R case" from the Basic Information screen of the open PE case.
- 6. Easter Seals will continue Post Employment monitoring.
