SUMMARY OF UPDATES

In QE2 the list of Impairments, Mental Retardation has been changed to Intellectual Disability. Many staff asked for this change as Special Education changed their terminology several years ago. While the Rehabilitation Services Administration has not changed our terminology we have decided to update QE2. This will allow the Vocational Evaluation reports to display Intellectual Disability when printed and shared with school or other personnel involved with our clients.
