SUMMARY OF UPDATE

The Post-Secondary Training Chapter section on "Basis for expecting successful completion" has been revised. Originally the section identified past academic achievement, passing scores on the U.S. Department of Education Ability to Benefit Test, intelligent test and psychometric tests is used for considering training success indicators. This list has been expanded to consider additional areas VR Staff and the client should consider including: verifying job goal/training is consistent with impairment and vocational implications, client's stamina, stability, learning style, training requirements, financial stability, transportation, goal setting/organizational skills, and required assistive technology/students supports. The additional areas have always been relevant and important to consider, however they have now been added to the chapter.
