FUNDING THE AA/AAS DEGREE IN LAW ENFORCEMENT EFFECTIVE DATE: APRIL 17, 2006

CHANGE

The new College Cooperative Program between the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center (N.L.E.T.C.) and the community colleges presents a funding matter for the agency requiring some guidance.

VR will participate in funding of the 14 week law enforcement certification training program conducted at the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center that is a part of the AA/AAS Degree in Law Enforcement. The chapter identifies the maximum amounts VR will pay toward the N.L.E.T.C. training fee, books, miscellaneous supplies and equipment and how the N.L.E.T.C. certification training costs are authorized in QUEST.

VRIS UPDATE

This chapter has been posted as a sub-chapter to the Post Secondary Training Chapter. The path is VRIS: Program Manual: Community Services: Post Secondary Training: Funding the AA/AAS Degree in Law Enforcement.

QUEST CHANGES

The N.L.E.T.C. tuition, books, miscellaneous supplies and equipment are authorized as Miscellaneous Training: Skill Training. Since the student pays these cost to the community college who in turn pays N.L.E.T.C., the payee can either be the community college or the student.

TEAM COMMUNICATION

A team review of this chapter should take place to initially inform staff of the degree program and this contents of this chapter. The team is further encouraged to visit the N.L.E.T.C. website to become more familiar with the College Cooperative Program and the law enforcement labor market. It is further recommended that the team looks at the AA/AAS Degree in Law Enforcement Program information on the catalog of their nearest community college.
