SUMMARY OF UPDATES

To more effectively document Borderline Intellectual Functioning on the Impairment Screen in a consumer's QUEST record, borderline intellectual functioning (IQ 71-84) has been added to the Mental Functioning-Developmental value list in QUEST. Previously, the instructions were to select mental retardation-mild and add the label Borderline Intellectual Functioning in the field below the QUEST impairment field. The Eligibility and Transition chapters have been revised to reflect this change.
