SUMMARY OF UPDATES

The chapter outlines the process for arranging for Video Remote Interpreting in VR Offices. Currently, Deaf Services Unlimited is the only provide with Nebraska Licensed Interpreters.

When VRI services are needed, Tibor will need to be contacted to set up the required software and to assist in testing the connection. VRI will only be available on VR desktop and laptop computers with a camera. As the iPad version of the VIDYO software improves, there may be a time in the future when VRI will be available on the iPad.
