VRIS UPDATE

Transition Chapter Effective June 12, 2007 Number 78

SUMMARY OF UPDATES:

Several updates to the TR Chapter and TR processes have been made. Updates include the following:

- 1. Clarification regarding the Transition Services Consent and Information Release form and the provision of group and individual TR services.
- 2. Includes a provision that allows TR services to be provided to students who reside in bordering states and attend a Nebraska school.
- 3. Eliminates Transition Employment Warranty Monitoring.
- 4. Includes guidance on the use of the IPE Booklet in Transition.
- 5. Permits job placement assistance in the TR Program the summer after the student graduates from school; however, does not permit a referral to Placement Program staff.
- 6. Provides clarification regarding requirements to take a Transition Employment Outcome.
- 7. Eliminates the requirement to develop a plan within 90 days of eligibility for transition students in the Employment Program.
- 8. Now includes reference to and information regarding the Transition Packet "Resources for the Transition Educator".
- 9. Provides clarification regarding the provision of transition services for students who no longer verify for special education.
- 10. Provides clarification and guidance on working with students who have an MDT of Mental Handicap –Mild.
- 11. Specifies that a copy of the Multidisciplinary Team (MDT) Report is required for the verification of a disability, eliminating the option of using a copy of the IEP.
- 12. Specifies that students who have dropped out of school should be opened in the I & R Program.

The Transition Consent form was revised and a Change Announcement regarding those changes was sent out 2/2007.
