Serving Non-Citizens Effective 3/2/12 Number 333

SUMMARY OF UPDATES

The Citizenship/non-citizen section of the Application and Transfer to the Employment Program chapter has been updated to allow for more Non-immigrant Aliens with disabilities to be served by the VR program. Non-immigrant aliens by definition have permission to temporarily live and temporarily work in the United States. The temporary status can encompass a period of years and can be revoked.

A Non-immigrant Alien with a disability and a current Employment Authorization Document (EAD) that has been verified through the USCIS-SAVE program can be found eligible for the VR program. A critical question to explore with the individual is the extent to which their Non-immigrant Alien status and situation will allow them to be present and available for the duration of their anticipated IPE services and outcome.

MONITORING REQUIREMENTS

Monitoring will occur through the Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlement (SAVE) checks conducted at the state office.
