I hereby attest that my responses and the information provided on this form for services are true, complete, and accurate. I give my consent for Nebraska VR to exchange information with school staff, mentors, Educational Service Unit staff, Post-secondary Institutions, Access Nebraska, Assistive Technology Partnership specialists, NE Commission for the Blind & Visually Impaired, NE Developmental Disabilities, NE Department of Labor, Social Security Administration, and Employers (past, current or prospective). Nebraska VR will not re-release the education records it receives from the above named school to any other person, program, or agency without my written consent unless it is required by law.
