Type of Information	Directions
Classification Study	No release is required. Call or fax Ginger or Barb with name, SSN, DOB and DCS ID #. Classification Study cannot be further released nor shown to the former inmate. Inmates cannot request a copy of their Classification Study from the Dept. of Correctional Services.
Medical	Inmate authorization is required. Include DCS ID #. Inmates can request a copy of their medical records from the Dept. of Correctional Services. In request, specify the condition about which you are requesting information and approximate dates of treatment. Inmates with long sentences can have a fairly extensive record. Records Clerk on duty will call if they need more specific information or you can call after you have sent the release to clarify your request.
Mental Health	Inmate authorization is required. Include DCS ID #. Information is not to be further released or shared with former inmates. In Types of Information section under "Other available information", indicate your purpose for requesting mental health information. Actual records will not be released; a summary report will be provided. It may take up to 30 days for requests to be filled.
Alcohol and Drugs	Inmate authorization is required. Include DCS ID #. Information is not to be further released or shared with former inmates. In Types of Information section under "Other available information", indicate your purpose for requesting drug and alcohol information.
